Purpose:

To visit the Day Worker Center to learn more about their community health improvement work as well as the work funded by the El Camino Healthcare District in FY2024.

Summary:

Community Partnerships staff was asked to set up District Board Grant Partner Site Visits so that District Board members can learn firsthand about some of the important community health improvement work being done by agencies. The site visit to the Day Worker Center is being noticed as a quorum of the District Board wishes to attend.

Background:

- The Day Worker Center of Mountain View was founded in 1996 by local business, church and community leaders.
- The Center provides job-matching services for residents and businesses in Mountain View, Los Altos, Los Altos Hills, Sunnyvale, Palo Alto and surrounding areas.
- Each year the Day Worker Center serves about 500 unduplicated day workers and their families. Thanks to their broad network of over 100 volunteers, they offer English classes, job skill workshops and presentations for ongoing improvements in physical, mental and emotional health. The Center partners with local organizations to assist with medical, dental, optometric and legal services for the workers.
- The El Camino Healthcare District funding supports the Healthy Meals Program, which benefits the day workers and their families, improving their physical, mental and emotional health. Meals prepared at the Center are nutritious and culturally relevant. Following a healthy diet has many benefits, including building strong bones, protecting the heart, preventing disease, and boosting mood. Their workshops and activities improve health and increase energy and overall well-being. Holistic approaches are a priority, helping all aspects of physical, mental and emotional health. These services are greatly needed by the day workers who are among the lowest income and most under-served and vulnerable populations, compounded by the extreme difficulties caused by the housing crisis. The Center provides healthy meals six days a week for the day workers and their families, promoting healthy bodies and healthy minds. The need for nutritious food has increased due to the underemployment of the low-income workers they serve. The Day Worker Center takes appropriate actions so the workers do not go hungry. The current FY2024 grant award aims to provide 4,200 meals to 350 individuals in the ECHD boundaries this year.
